Lamentations 5:1-22

- (1) As you reflect on today's sermon, how would you answer these 4 questions?
 - Who is God (what does this passage tell me about God's character)?
 - What has God done (how do I see God's character in action)?
 - Who am I (how does God's character and action shape how I see myself)?
 - What do I do (if I believe the first 3, how would I respond and relate to others)?

- (2) In 5:19, we see the author again return to the bedrock of God's sovereignty, permanence, and stability. Why do you think those are so important during times of suffering or catastrophe?

- (3) The fall of Jerusalem because of their repetitive and unrepentant sin remained a teaching moment for Israel and something they looked back on to learn from. How can we learn from and grow from our failures, our sins, and times when we have not obeyed?

- (4) What is something you learned during this series on lament or ways this series has helped you? What's something that remains unclear to you, confusing, or is just hard to live out? How have you grown in knowing how to lament before the Lord during this series? What's something you'd like to continue to do or take away moving forward?

- (5) Is there anything you are experiencing or walking through right now that your GGC can pray with you about?
