Sundays @ TVC: We will gather each Sunday morning for worship @ 10 AM. Age appropriate note sheets and coloring sheets are available for the children as you enter the sanctuary. Please

We strive for family integrated worship and want to encourage parents to keep their children in the sanctuary or East Hall for worship. However, we understand that children can get restless & squirmy, so if you have to leave the service with your child, please feel free to do so. There is a kid friendly area in the Fellowship Hall, geared for children ages 0–4 years old, that can be used by families who have children that may need to get some wiggles out.
